For Joseph, the opportunity to study engineering would mean so much more than just a career; it would be a chance to lift his family out of their daily struggles and provide them with a better life.

Joseph lives in a small, single-room house made of mud and poles, which he shares with his mother and six siblings. His mother, who became a single parent at a young age, sells samosas by the roadside to support her family.



Despite her efforts, they struggle to meet even their basic needs. The rent for their home is 2,500 Ksh (around \$ 20 USD), and electricity adds an extra 300 Ksh (about \$2 USD) per month. Even these modest expenses can be overwhelming for Joseph's mother, who must also pay for access to water and basic sanitation, costing an additional 10 Ksh each time. Their home lacks a bathroom, and during the rainy season, water and mud seep inside, making it cold and unsafe, especially for Joseph's youngest sister, who was born with a serious medical condition that remains untreated due to financial constraints

Talking with Joseph, one senses his quiet resilience and a steadfast hope that drives him to persevere through these challenges. Despite his circumstances, he is committed to his studies, excelling in subjects that will one day allow him to pursue his dream of becoming an engineer. He believes that with the support of a sponsorship, he could not only succeed in school but also transform his family's future, providing them with the stability and security they so deeply need
